Compare Cabernet Sauvignon wines from Napa Valley, California, with Cabernet-based wines from Bordeaux in France. Include wines from top Bordeaux appellations like Pauillac and Saint-Émilion. This tasting will highlight the variations in Cabernet Sauvignon wines.

Explore Chardonnay wines from different regions, including Oregon, Napa Valley, Burgundy, and Italy. This tasting will showcase how winemaking techniques influence the flavor profiles of Chardonnay.

Italian Wine Journey

Focus solely on Italian wines from various regions. Include wines such as Barolo, Chianti Classico, Amaron, and Super Tuscans. Compare these Italian wines with a Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon to appreciate the diversity of Italian wine.
